

The School of Law offers a variety of pro bono opportunities that employ the diverse skills and interests of our student body. Whether it is helping a tenant avoid eviction or a low-income senior obtain critical estate planning documents, our students have the opportunity to experience a service-based legal education. By cultivating such service, the Center for Pro Bono & Public Service not only provides a valuable resource for the community, it also prepares students for a life of purposeful citizenship.

#### From CVLAS: October Pro Bono Opportunities

October 31st from 1-4:30 p.m. at the Petersburg Library; join a Wills Clinic cohosted with the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. We still need 4 additional lawyers and 3 paralegals. Register at www.justiceserver.org. No prior wills or estate training is needed as all training and support will be provided on site.

November 15th and December 13th from 12 p.m.-2p.m. Unlawful Detainer Expungement Clinics need attorneys to serve as hosts. Training provided during the clinic will educate attorneys to file petitions for individuals who have had unlawful detainers dismissed or non-suited removed from their court records. No court appearance is required, and this opportunity can be done remotely.

Legal Aid Justice Center's Pro Bono Housing Unit commitment consists of volunteering for at least four 1.5-hour appointment slots over the course of one year, in which you will advise approximately 3-5 clients each session and decide whether to offer further representation on a case-by-case basis. Currently the housing unit is operating by telephone, but occasionally pro bono attorneys may appear in court if they choose to offer full representation. A staff attorney will onboard you and offer to sit in on your initial call so that you know what to expect. There is a two and a half hour recorded training video that goes over Virginia Landlord Tenant Laws that will be provided and required before advising clients. A staff attorney will be provided as a resource to you for any of your consultation needs.


